RESIDENTS OF UNION AND KENILWORTH January 2010 – News Release

Pandemic H1N1 (Swine Influenza) is still spreading and may in a future wave spread among those who have not yet been immunized.

To prevent this virus from causing future illness and complications the Union and Kenilworth Health Departments have secured 2,500 doses of H1N1 vaccine.

This vaccine will be made available free of charge to anyone who has not yet received a H1N1 vaccination.

Our clinic is scheduled for Saturday, January 23rd from 1PM to 5PM at the Township of Union Senior Center at 968 Bonnel Court in Union. Each person must complete a consent form and bring it with them. Consent forms can be obtained from municipal websites, municipal buildings and health departments in both Union and Kenilworth. If a child under 10 years of age has received a first dose and will need a second dose proof of the 1st dose must be provided along with a consent form. This clinic is open to anyone regardless of age who would like to be vaccinated.

Over 6650 vaccinations have been administered to date since November and the vaccine is safe and effective. Join us if you wish to be vaccinated.
